- Supervise, direct, assign and evaluate the work of direct reports
- Maintain seamless communication within the ramp department and with other departments to ensure efficient operations
- Develop and manage performance objectives
- Conduct performance reviews, coaching and disciplinary action as required, liaising with HR to ensure proper process and documentation takes place
- Monitor and improve on-time performance, ramp effectiveness and safety
- Assume any responsibilities delegated by the Director of Ground Operations
- Liaise with other company departments such as Passenger Services and Cargo in developing policies and procedures to ensure consistencies are met across the company
- Develop all initial and recurrent training programs required for Ramp operations, including training curricula, online courses and assessment tools
- Develop and maintain a 'train the trainer' program
