Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, the Apprentice AME is a mechanic who is in the process of obtaining the training, knowledge, experience and skill required to obtain an AME M2 rated license. The Apprentice AME works under direct supervision of an ACA, tasks preformed satisfactorily while under direct supervision of qualified staff are eligible to be entered into the apprentice's maintenance log book for purpose of meeting the Transport Canada criteria for acquisition of an AME M2 rated license.

Duties and Responsibilities Under ACA Supervision:

- Receive aircraft maintenance tasks (on the job training) by an ACA prior to accomplishing the task
- Conduct maintenance, repairs, and modifications to aircraft using approved tools, materials and manuals
- Perform scheduled and unscheduled maintenance tasks
- Troubleshoot and rectify aircraft system defects
- Ensure the Company's safety standards are adhered to at all times
- Ensure work accomplished is correctly documented and recorded
- Verify parts installed onto the aircraft are properly certified, prior to installation
- Ensure the Company's hanger facilities, tooling and equipment are maintained to industry standards
- Understand and comply with all regulatory requirements and Company policies, manuals, and documentation requirements in accordance with Airworthiness Certification Authority
- Liaise with Stores on parts needed, used, and accounted for
- Create and complete task cards and non-routine cards (NRC)
- Complete training courses and attend programs as required
- Perform other duties as directed by the Maintenance Manager, Planner(s), or ACA

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Excellent written/oral communication skills with strong listening
- Ability to effectively work individually and as part of a team.
- Experience working with aircraft operated by the Company (B737-200/-3/4/5 and/or ATR 42-300/320) would be considered an asset
- Excellent troubleshooting and analytical skills
- Adept with use of a wide variety of tools and test equipment (e.g., wrenches, sockets, test equipment)
- A dedication to continuous learning

Qualifications/Conditions of Employment:

- Successful completion of required Company indoctrination, general, and recurrent training
- Receive training on: Reduced Vertical Separation Minimum (RVSM) and Aircraft De-icing
- Receive aircraft maintenance tasks (on the job training) by an ACA prior to accomplishing the task
- Receive "on the job training" from ACA(s) in order to complete the experience and skill required to obtain an AME License
- Record accomplishment of tasks in personnel log book
- Required to maintain a valid Restricted Area Identification Card (RAIC)
- Required to maintain a valid class 5 driver's license with a clean abstract
- Required to maintain a valid Airside Vehicle Operator's Permit for ENWIA
- Required to maintain a valid Restricted Operator's Certificate Aeronautical
- Be physically fit (able to lift up to 50 pounds repetitively, able to stand/walk for extended periods of time, work in a pressurized environment)
- Valid Basic Training from a Transport Canada Accredited Program is an asset
- Must be a Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or show proof of right to work in Canada

Please note that the positions will only be available **in Whitehorse**. Selected candidates must be **willing to relocate**. Relocation expenses are not reimbursed.
